Rising to 231 feet Bidston Hill is one of the highest points on the Wirral. Its 100 acres of heathland and woodland contain mysterious rock carvings and historic buildings, as well as being a haven for wildlife amidst the urban sprawl.

The Friends of Bidston Hill are a local community group created to watch over and assist in the management and improvement of this beautiful conservation area.

Our aim is to support the development of Bidston Hill for the local, wider and global community, whilst striving to maintain the Hill's unique character. The Friends work in partnership with Wirral Council Parks & Countryside Service creating new ideas and projects for the benefit of the Hill and its users.

Each week we have a Friday Group that do various tasks on the Hill. This is organised by our local Ranger, so if you have some time to spare and don't mind getting 'stuck in' why not come along at around 10.00am on a Friday morning? We meet at the Tam O'Shanter Farm and have a cup of tea and a friendly chat before starting work. Tasks include: litter picking, pruning of trees, shrubs and gorse, path maintenance and a whole lot more. We are a friendly lot and you will be providing a very useful contribution to the work done by our volunteers.

We also open Bidston Windmill to the public during the warmer months, run guided walks on Bidston Hill, arrange events like the annual Bidston Hill Family Open Day, maintain the Bidston Hill Heritage Trail and run a website.

A family membership is only £5.00 per year! Even if you don't have time to volunteer, your membership will still help to keep Bidston Hill a very special place.
